

GPN-GL12 Purchasing Guidelines for

Television Sets

Green Purchasing Network (GPN)

1. Scope

These guidelines cover important environmental issues that shall be considered when purchasing television sets.

2. Guidelines

When purchasing television sets, the following articles shall be considered for purchasing products with as little environmental burden as possible.

- (1) Minimum power consumption during operation and stand-by mode
- (2) The manufacturer provides full maintenance service in order to make long-term use feasible
- (3) Designed to facilitate disassembling and recycling of component parts
- (4) Made of recycled plastics as much as possible
- (5) Does not contain lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium compounds, or specific bromine-based flame-retardants (PBB, PBDE), to the utmost extent possible
