

GPN-GL5 Purchasing Guidelines for

Refrigerators

Green Purchasing Network (GPN)

1. Scope

These guidelines cover important environmental issues that shall be considered when purchasing refrigerators.

2. Guidelines

When purchasing refrigerators and freezers, the following articles shall be considered for purchasing products with as little environmental burden as possible.

- (1) Minimal power consumption during operation
- (2) Materials for refrigerants and foaming agents that have minimal impacts to ozone layer depletion and global warming
- (3) The manufacturer provides full maintenance service in order to make long-term use feasible
- (4) Designed to facilitate disassembling and recycling of component parts
- (5) Made of recycled plastics as much as possible
- (6) Does not contain lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium compounds, or specific bromine-based flame-retardants (PBB, PBDE), to the utmost extent possible
